The Poster Making Competition aimed to achieve several educational objectives for participants:


Visual Communication: Students learned how to convey complex ideas concisely through visual elements, a skill applicable in presentations, marketing materials, and business reports.

He briefed the students about the background of Bose, he was the son of a wealthy and prominent Bengali lawyer and studied at Presidency College and the Scottish Churches College, Kolkata. He further proceeded, to the University of Cambridge in England to prepare for the Indian Civil Service. In 1920 he passed the civil service examination, but in April 1921, after hearing of the nationalist turmoils in India, he resigned his candidacy and hurried back to India.

Bose then joined the Indian National Congress and actively participated in the Indian independence movement. He was a close associate of Mahatma Gandhi and Jawaharlal Nehru, but later broke away from them due to ideological differences. In 1939, he formed the Forward Bloc, an organization aimed at unifying all the anti-British forces in India. In August 1945, Bose was killed in a plane crash in Taiwan.

Dr. Bhupatkar, pointed out the various facets of leadership quality in Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. He advised students to be firm on the choices they make and live by example in their life.




7. Extension Activities -
